



RESOLUTION 21-37

Resolution Rejecting the Bid for the Community WiFi Project

WHEREAS, pursuant to a duly advertised Notice to Bidders, on December 29, 2020, the Municipality of Princeton received one (1) bid for the Community WiFi Project from Andrena, Inc. of New York; and

WHEREAS, consistent with N.J.S.A. 40A:11-4, a contract subject to bidding may only be awarded to the lowest responsible bidder, which is defined as the bidder (1) who offers the lowest price and is responsive, and (2) who is responsible; and

WHEREAS, Andrena, Inc. was not registered under New Jersey's Public Works Contractor Registration Act at the time of bidding, which was a mandatory requirement for bidding on this project, and is therefore unresponsive.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Princeton Council on this 19th day of January, 2021 that:

- 1. The "Whereas" clauses are hereby incorporated herein as if fully restated.
2. Andrena, Inc's bid submitted on December 29, 2020 for the Community WiFi Project is hereby rejected as unresponsive.
3. The Administrator, Clerk, Attorney and such other officials are hereby authorized and directed to re-advertise for the solicitation of bids for the Community WiFi Project.
