



RESOLUTION 21-56

Resolution Approving the Extension Date of Removal of the Placement Pole Banners on Nassau Street by the Princeton University Art Museum, from Saturday, January 30, 2021 to Saturday, May 29, 2021

WHEREAS, The Princeton University Art Museum is planning on focusing on variety of faces in art; and

WHEREAS, The Princeton University Art Museum had permission to install eight pole banners on Nassau Street on Resolution 20-308 that was approved at the December 14, 2020 Council meeting with the removal date of Saturday, January 30, 2021 has requested permission for an extension date of removal for Saturday, May 29, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the pole banners will be promptly removed after use as required by Borough ordinances; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Borough Ordinance 3-17 any banner that is removed by Princeton will be held by Princeton for thirty (30) days and then disposed of; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Borough Ordinance 3-17 any applicant failing to remove a banner will not be permitted to display any banner for the succeeding two years; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor and Council hereby approve the extension date placement of said pole banners on Nassau Street in accordance with Borough Ordinances 3-14-3-17.
