



RESOLUTION 21-96

Resolution Authorizing the Hiring of Robert Bruschi as Interim Administrator

WHEREAS, current Princeton Administrator Marc D. Dashield will be retiring effective April 1, 2021; and

WHEREAS, a search is currently underway for a new administrator; and

WHEREAS, Robert Bruschi has expressed a desire to serve on a part-time basis as Princeton's interim administrator until such time as Mr. Dashield's successor has been retained; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Bruschi served as the Administrator for the former Borough of Princeton from 1999 until the Borough's consolidation with the former Township of Princeton, then served as the Administrator for the consolidated municipality until his retirement in June 2014; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Bruschi is intimately familiar with the municipality and is eminently qualified to serve as Princeton's interim administrator; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council therefore wish to approve Mr. Bruschi's employment with Princeton in that capacity;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Council of the Municipality of Princeton in Mercer County, New Jersey, as follows:


1. Robert Bruschi is hereby hired on a part-time basis to serve as interim administrator for Princeton, on the following terms and conditions:
 - a. Mr. Bruschi's start date shall be March 17, 2021. He shall be expected to work twenty-five weekday daytime hours per week. He shall also be expected to work at other times and attend meetings as necessary in the performance of his duties.
 - b. Mr. Bruschi shall be compensated for his services at a rate of \$125 per hour.
 - c. It is expressly agreed to and understood that Mr. Bruschi shall not be entitled to any health benefits or paid time off.
 - d. In his capacity as interim administrator, Mr. Bruschi shall have all of the authority and perform all of the duties of Princeton municipal administrator set forth in sections 2-1 through 2-1.6 of the "Code of the Borough of Princeton, New Jersey 1968."

2. Mr. Bruschi shall serve as interim administrator until such time as outgoing administrator Marc D. Dashield's successor has been appointed (anticipated to be six to eight weeks). The foregoing notwithstanding, it is expressly agreed to and understood that the Council may at any time terminate Mr. Bruschi's appointment, with or without cause, and the provisions of *N.J.S.A.* 40A:9-138 shall not apply to such termination.

3. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
