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**RESOLUTION 21-78**

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**Resolution Amending 2020-2021 Agreement With Central Jersey Waste and Recycling, Inc. and Approving Change Order No. 1 in the Not to Exceed Amount of \$104,950.00**

**WHEREAS**, by Resolution 19-380, the Municipality of Princeton awarded a one-year contract for solid and bulky waste collection, removal and disposal services to Central Jersey Waste and Recycling, Inc. in the amount of \$566,730.00, based on a unit price of \$104.95 and an estimated 5,400 tons of waste, for the term of February 1, 2020 through January 31, 2021 (“Agreement”); and

**WHEREAS**, the Department of Infrastructure and Operations reports that the actual tonnage of waste collected, removed, and disposed of under the Agreement is anticipated to exceed the estimated 5,400 tons in the Agreement by approximately 1,000 tons; and

**WHEREAS**, the increase in tonnage is as a result of COVID-19, which was not reasonably foreseeable at the time of originally soliciting bids for the Agreement; and

**WHEREAS**, the Engineering Department and Administrator recommend that a change order in the not to exceed amount of one hundred four thousand nine hundred fifty dollars and no cents (\$104,950.00) be authorized to increase the total tons collected, removed and disposed of under the Agreement, through the end of the term on January 31, 2021; and

**WHEREAS**, the Chief Financial Officer has certified the availability of adequate funds as required by law in the accounts 01-203-26-305-273 (for December figure) and 01-201-26-305-276 (for January figure).


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the Municipality of


Princeton, County of Mercer, State of New Jersey as follows:

1. The Solid and Bulky Waste Collection, Removal and Disposal Services Contract with Central Jersey Waste and Recycling, Inc., 432 Stokes Avenue, Ewing, New Jersey 08638 is hereby amended by increasing the tonnage under the Agreement from 5,400 tons to 6,400 tons of waste, for the term ending on January 31, 2021.
2. As a result of the increase in tonnage, the total not to exceed contract amount for the Agreement from February 1, 2020 through January 31, 2021 is \$671,680.00.
3. When countersigned by Central Jersey Waste and Recycling, Inc., this Resolution shall serve as an amendment to the Agreement and memorialize the approval of Change Order No. 1.
4. A copy of this Resolution shall be placed on file in the office of the Municipal Clerk.
