**RESOLUTION 21-172**

**Resolution Authorizing a Contract with Earle Asphalt Company of Farmingdale, New Jersey in the Not to Exceed Amount of \$22,811.40 for the Procurement, Delivery and Installation of One Hundred Eighty Feet of Concrete Jersey Barrier and Eight Crash Barrels on Quaker Road for Vehicular Safety and Streambank Slope Protection in the Vicinity of 44 and 28 Quaker Road**

**WHEREAS**, the Municipality of Princeton desires to contract with a vendor for the procurement, delivery, and installation of one hundred eighty feet of concrete jersey barrier and eight crash barrels for the purpose of providing vehicular safety on Quaker Road; and

**WHEREAS**, the Engineering Department contacted more than five vendors and / or contractors for quotes for the required goods and services detailed above; and

**WHEREAS**, the following two quotes were received:

1. \$22,811.40 quoted by Earle Asphalt Company of Farmingdale, New Jersey, and
2. \$25,552.00 quoted by Traffic Safety Service LLC of South Plainfield, New Jersey; and

**WHEREAS**, the Engineering Department recommends that a contract be executed with Earle Asphalt Company to performing the sought-after services of procuring, delivering and installing the concrete jersey barrier and crash barrels for the not to exceed contract amount of \$22,811.40; and

**WHEREAS**, Princeton has a need to acquire these services without a “fair and open process” as defined by P.L. 2004, c.19, the “Local Unit Pay-to-Play Law” and in connection therewith, Earle Asphalt Company has completed and filed with Princeton the required affidavit pursuant to section 2-87 of the Princeton Code; and

**WHEREAS**, the Chief Financial Officer has certified that sufficient funds are available to pay for said services from the capital account #04-215-19-021-076-347; and

**WHEREAS**, the Local Public Contracts Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-3a. authorizes Princeton to award this agreement without public bidding because it will not exceed the bid threshold.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the Municipality of Princeton, County of Mercer, State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to execute an agreement with Earle Asphalt Company to procure, deliver and install one hundred eighty feet of concrete jersey barriers and eight crash barrels, consistent with this Resolution and the above “Whereas” clauses.


2. The agreement is awarded without competitive bidding as authorized by N.J.S.A. 40A:11-3a.

3. Earle Asphalt Company shall be paid a fee not to exceed \$22,811.40. The term of the agreement shall be to procure, deliver and install above mentioned product as soon as it is available per Earle Asphalt Company’s quote.

4. A copy of this Resolution and the agreement shall be placed on file in the Office of the Clerk.
