



RESOLUTION 21-178

Resolution Amending the Professional Services Agreement for Miller, Porter & Muller PC for the Amended Amount Not to Exceed \$47,500.00

WHEREAS, Princeton wishes to retain the services of professional legal services to the Planning Board as legal counsel to the Planning Board; and

WHEREAS, Miller, Porter & Muller, P.C. (“CONSULTANT”) has agreed to provide the sought-after services to Princeton on an as-needed basis, in accordance with the rates set forth in

CONSULTANT’s proposal dated February 10, 2020, a copy of which is on file in the office of the

Princeton Clerk, for an estimated not-to-exceed cost of thirty-seven thousand dollars (\$37,000.00); and

WHEREAS, Princeton finds a need to increase by \$10,500.00 for the anticipated not to exceed amount to \$47,500.00 ; and

WHEREAS, the term of the agreement shall be for the 2020 year contract from the date on which was executed; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer has certified that sufficient funds are available to pay for said services; and

WHEREAS, the Local Public Contracts Law, *N.J.S.A. 40A:11-5(1)(a)(i)*, authorizes Princeton to award this agreement as a professional services agreement, without public bidding.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Municipality of Princeton, County of Mercer, State of New Jersey, as follows:


1. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to execute an agreement with CONSULTANT, to provide legal services to Princeton Planning Board as

described in the preamble to this resolution, at the rates set forth of the CONSULTANT.

2. The agreement is awarded without competitive bidding as a professional services agreement as authorized under N.J.S.A. 40A:11-5(1)(a)(i).
3. The agreement shall terminate one year from the date of its execution or when the above-referenced services are no longer needed, whichever shall first occur.
4. A copy of this resolution, the Pay-to-Play Forms and the agreement shall be kept on file in the Office of the Clerk.
5. A notice of this action shall be published in Princeton’s official newspaper as required by law.
6. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
