



# PRINCETON bicycle master plan

## Study Background

The purpose of the Bicycle Master Plan is to identify bicycle infrastructure improvements in order to create a regionally connected bicycle network within Princeton. The goal of the study is to develop and adopt a bicycle network plan that connects destinations within Princeton and links to adjacent communities and regional trails. The plan will designate the appropriate bicycle treatment for each segment of the network, and identify potential ordinance changes that are required to accommodate such a treatment.

The Bicycle Master Plan will:

- Help Princeton **advance its Complete Streets policy** by making Princeton's streets more accommodating for users of all ages, modes, and abilities
- Create a **more comfortable and safe environment**, encouraging increased bicycling in Princeton
