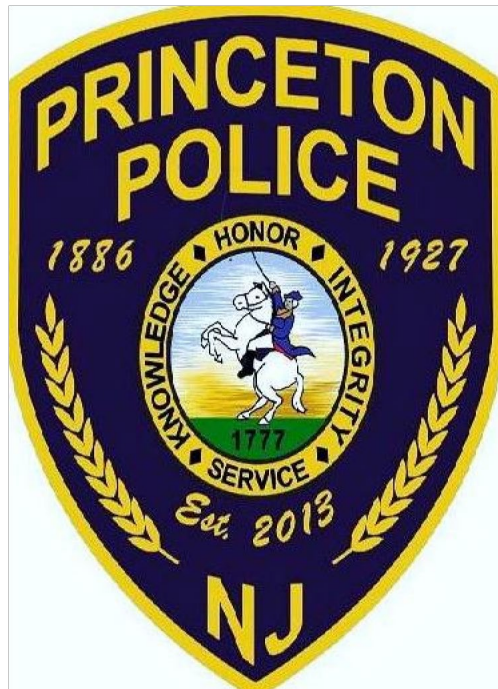

January 2021: The SNB saw the turn-over of one of its members with Ptl. Navas taking the place of Ptl. Gering. Although Ptl. Navas is now considered to be in the SNB, both her and Ptl. Donnelly are currently assigned to a patrol squad due to the change in schedules for Covid. Despite the turnover and change in schedules, the SNB was able to participate in several community policing events.

Activities:

- ❖ January 7: SNB participated in the monthly PADA meeting (Princeton Alcohol and Drug Alliance) via video conference
- ❖ January 7: SNB participated in a Juvenile Justice Reform Training

- ❖ January 27: SNB attended the Diversity Council Meeting via video conference.

Other activities of note:

SNB officers handled thirteen school crossings, performed three vacant house checks, and continue to conduct community policing events. SNB officers also conducted traffic details, assisted PPD patrols as backup on calls for service, and were the primary officers on eighty-four calls for service. SNB also installed 1 car seat for a community member and completed a number of administrative assignments. The SNB continues to manage all of our department’s social media platforms which reached over eighteen thousand people last month.

Notable Cases/Events

Case 20-15850

Detective Mathews completed a seven month long investigation into a former employee of the Princeton Medical Group stealing over \$43,000 from the Medical Group. After gathering evidence Det. Mathews interviewed the suspect Lilada Drager who admitted to issuing fraudulent patient refund checks which resulted in the diversion of over \$14,000.00 from Princeton Medical Group. She also admitted to a cash skimming scheme that she was operating which resulted in the diversion of over \$43,000.00 from Princeton Medical Group.

After the completion of her arrest processing, Drager was served with a Complaint Summons (S 2021 000019) charging her with 2C:21-15 (Misapplication of Entrusted Property), 2C:21-1a(2) [Forgery - False Authentication of a Writing], 2C:20-25c (Computer Criminal Activity - Access with Purpose to Defraud or Steal), and 2C:20-4 (Theft by Deception). All third degree charges.

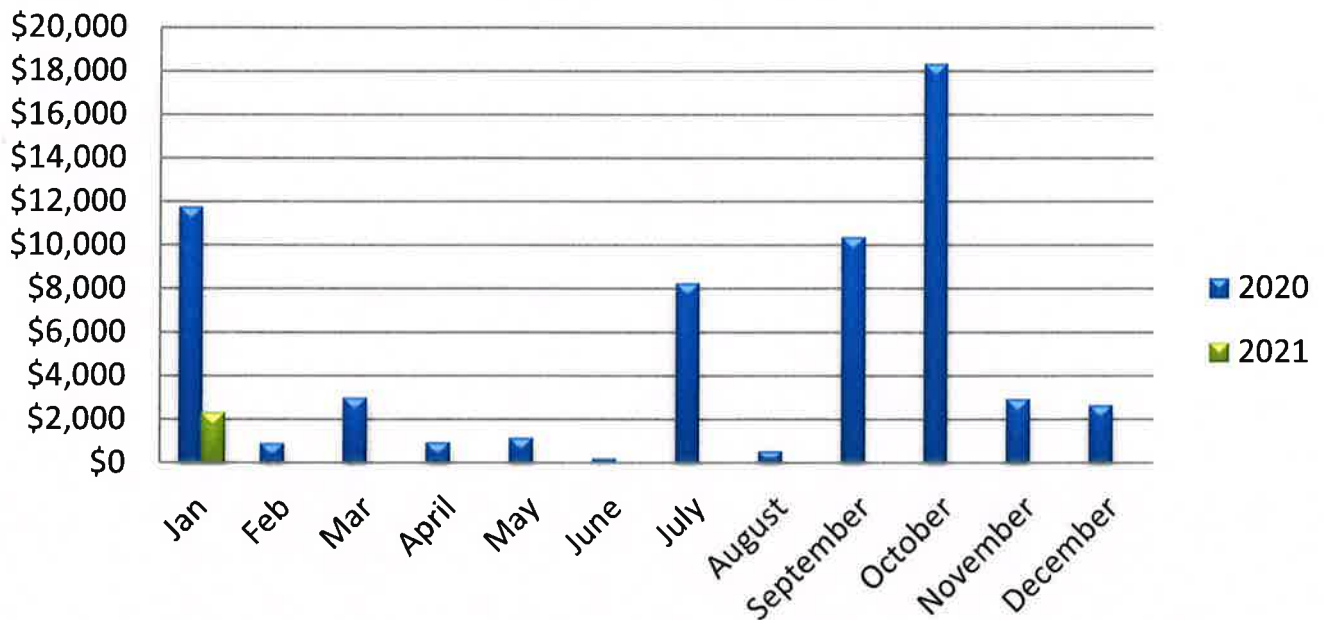

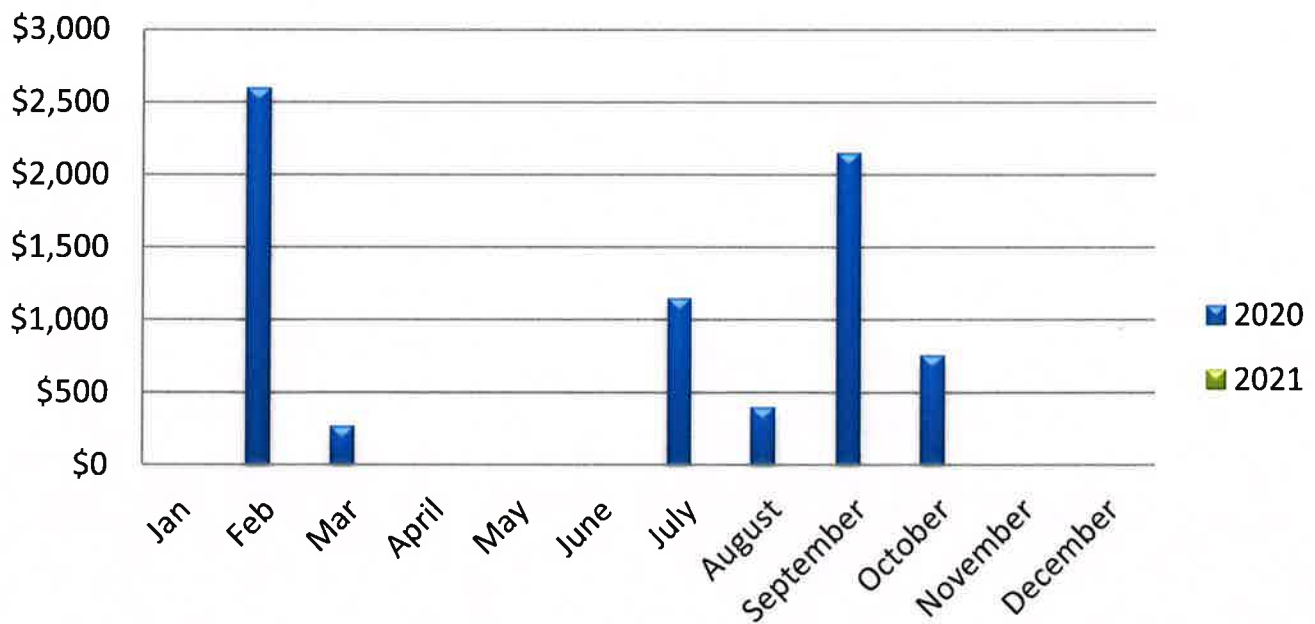

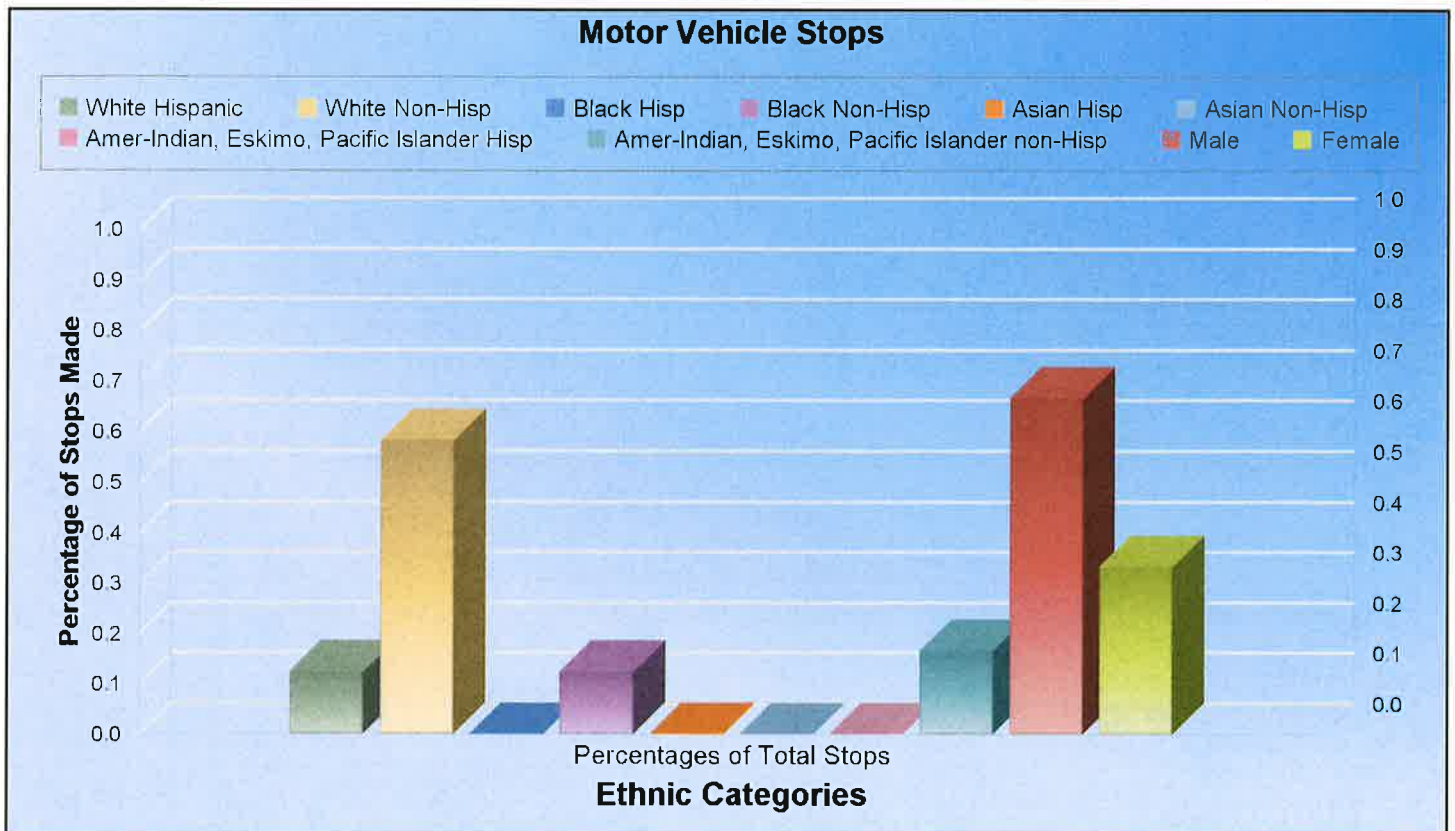
Gender & Ethnicity Report MV Stops for January 2021

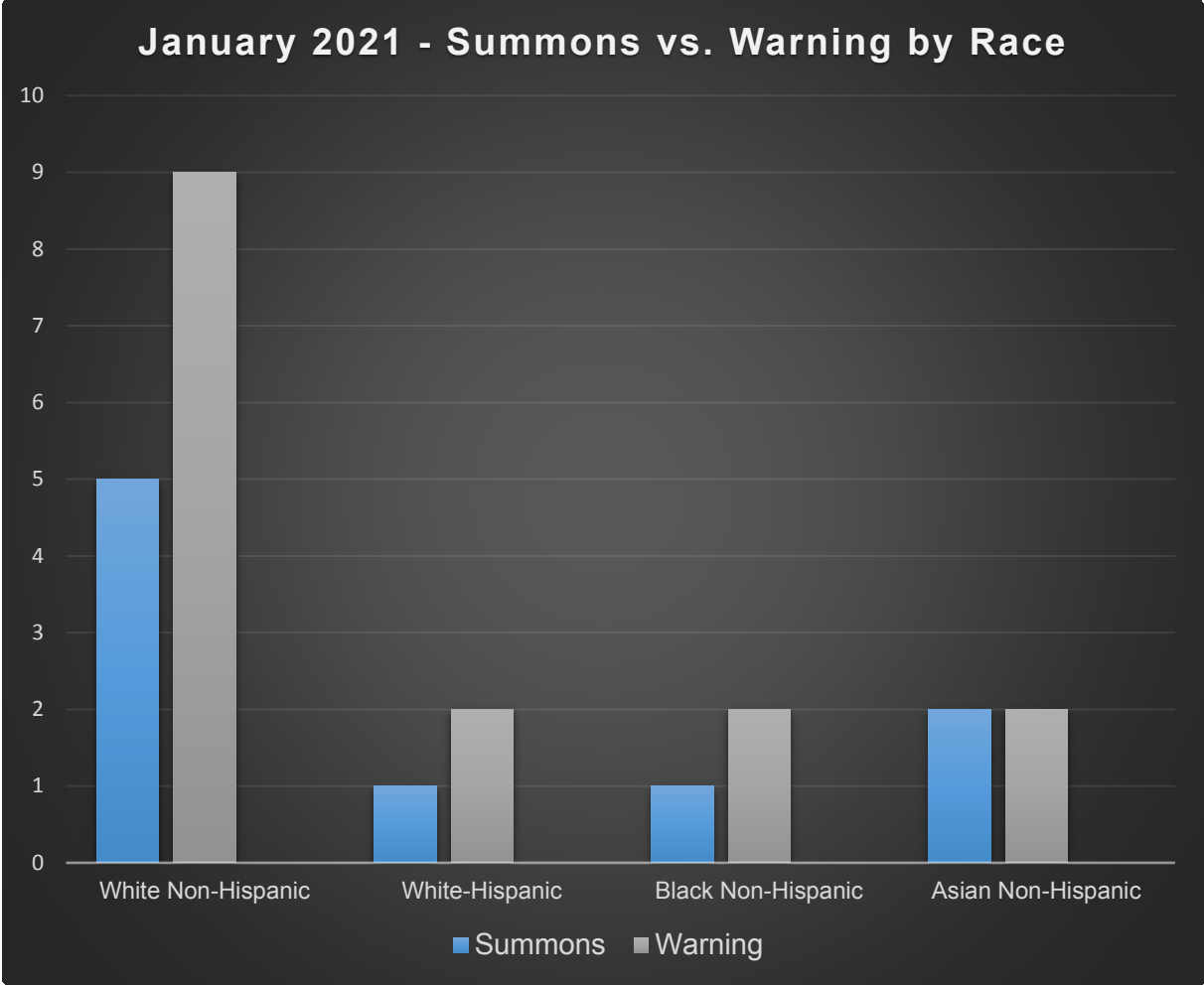
