The Traffic and Transportation Committee assists Mayor and Council in reviewing traffic and transportation issues. One member is also a member of the PBAC. The Committee carries out other advisory, educational and informational functions as well as promoting traffic and transportation issues. The Committee is governed by Municipal Law.

In addition, the Committee has traditionally provided leadership in Princeton to address issues of traffic and pedestrian safety. The committee partners with existing municipal organizations, local institutions, businesses, service organizations -- and the public in general -- to continually foster a safer Princeton. In collaboration with municipal functions the Committee's work includes addressing structural issues related to pedestrian and traffic safety, for example traffic lights, crosswalks, sidewalks and traffic calming.
