

## NOTICE TO BIDDERS

Notice is hereby given that Princeton will receive sealed bids for:

### **1500 GALLON TRUCK MOUNTED SEWER JET WITH TELESCOPIC ROTATING HOSE REEL**

Bids may be submitted by mail or in person and will be received by the Municipal Clerk at the Witherspoon Hall, 400 Witherspoon Street, Princeton, New Jersey 08540 until **11:00 a.m. on Tuesday, September 24, 2013** at which time they will be publicly opened and read. Bids received after this time will be disqualified.

Contract documents may be obtained at the office of the Princeton Sewer Operating Committee (PSOC) located at Monument Hall, One Monument Drive, Princeton, New Jersey, 08540, during regular business hours, 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, upon payment of a fee of \$25.00. In accordance with 297 N.J. Super 473, 688 A.2d 632, the bidder's list will not be disclosed.

All bids shall be prepared on approved bid forms, which shall be submitted in a sealed envelope addressed to the Municipal Clerk, Witherspoon Hall, 400 Witherspoon Street, Princeton, New Jersey 08540. The envelope shall bear the name and address of the bidder as well as the title of the project.

Each bid must be accompanied by bid security in the amount of 10% of the bid price or \$20,000.00, whichever is less. Said security shall be in the form of a certified check; cashiers check or bid bond, payable to the Municipality of Princeton.

The successful bidder will be required to furnish a performance bond in an amount equal to the contract price.

Bidders are advised that they must comply with the provisions set forth in the New Jersey Public Law, Chapter 127, PL 1975, which was enacted into law on June 23, 1975. This law relates to discrimination in connection with certain public contracts and supplements the "Law Against Discrimination" approved April 6, 1945 (PL 1945, C 169), and the State of New Jersey Public Disclosure Law (Public Laws of 1977). Bidders are required to comply with the requirements of N.J.S.A. 10:5-31 et seq. and N.J.A.C. 17:27.

This contract is expected to be funded in part with funds from the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection and the New Jersey Environmental Infrastructure Trust. Neither the State of New Jersey, the New Jersey Environmental Infrastructure Trust nor any of their departments, agencies or employees is, or will be, a party to this contract or subcontract or any lower tier contract or subcontract. This contract is subject to the provisions of N.J.A.C. 7:22-3, 4, 5, 9 and 10. (N.J.A.C. 7:22-3.17(d), 4.17(d))

No bid may be withdrawn within sixty (60) days after the date set for bid opening.

Princeton reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive any informality as deemed to be in the best interest of the Princeton.
