Re: **Proposed Ordinance Establishing No Parking Zone on a Portion of Alexander Street**



The Princeton Traffic Safety Officer, Sergeant Thomas R. Murray, has recommended establishing on the west side of Alexander Street south of Faculty Road a no parking zone. This area is directly across the street from the Princeton University Fire Response Station and establishing the no parking zone as recommended will facilitate safe turning movements by the fire equipment.

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**AN ORDINANCE CREATING A
NO PARKING ZONE ON A
PORTION OF ALEXANDER
STREET AND AMENDING THE
"CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF
PRINCETON, NEW JERSEY,
1968".**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of Princeton as follows:

Section 1. Section 11-12 of the "Code of the Township of Princeton, New Jersey, 1968" which establishes no parking zones within Princeton is amended by adding thereto the following designation in alphabetical order for Alexander Street and shall read as follows:

Alexander Street. West side, beginning at a point 263 feet south of the southerly line of Faculty Road and proceeding south therefrom for a distance of 105 feet to a point 368 feet from said line of Faculty Road.

Section 2. Regulatory and warning signs shall be posted to implement this no parking regulation.


Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication as required by law.

Please see the attached memorandum from Sergeant Thomas R. Murray dated May 22, recommending the following addition to Section 11-12 of the Code pertaining to “no parking at any time”

“Alexander Street, West side, beginning at a point 263’ south of the southerly line of Faculty Road and proceeding south therefrom for a distance of 105’ to a point 368’ from said line of Faculty Road”

Sergeant Murray has made this recommendation to provide for the safe operation of the Princeton University Fire Response Station that is situated along Alexander Street at this location.

The Princeton Traffic & Transportation Subcommittee has considered this matter and concurs with Sergeant Murray’s recommendation.



Subject: Proposed Ordinance Adjustment for Attorney Review (Alexander Street).

Proposed addition to existing Section 11-12 zone ordinance(s) along western side of Alexander Street in response to newly established 'No Parking' zone located across from #306 Alexander Street in relation to establishment of Princeton University Fire Response Station.

After reviewing the striping plans and measurements reported by Princeton University in relation to this project, it is my recommendation that the following wording/paragraph be added to the existing Alexander Road 'No Parking Anytime Ordinance(s)' so that the aforementioned No Parking Anytime zone can be enforced:

"Alexander Street. West side, beginning at a point 263' south of the southerly line of Faculty Road and proceeding south therefrom for a distance of 105' to a point 368' from said southerly line of Faculty Road."
