**RESOLUTION OF  
PRINCETON MUNICIPALITY,  
MERCER COUNTY, NEW JERSEY**

**WHEREAS**, Princeton Municipality strives to save tax dollars, assure clean air and water, improve working and living environments to build a community that is sustainable economically and socially; a community which would thrive well into the new century; and

**WHEREAS**, Princeton Municipality wishes to build a model of government which benefits our residents now and far into the future with green community initiatives which are easy to replicate and affordable to implement; and

**WHEREAS**, the Princeton Township Committee and Princeton Borough Council previously established a Green Team Advisory Committee by resolutions adopted on June 25, 2012 and June 26, 2012, respectively; and

**WHEREAS**, Princeton Municipality wants to continue the process of focusing on "Green" issues by maintaining its certification under the Sustainable Jersey Program.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by Princeton Municipality that we do hereby reappoint a Green Team Advisory Committee consisting of eight members who shall be residents or employees of Princeton, appointed annually, but whose initial term of appointment shall be through December 31, 2014.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by Princeton Municipality that the Mission, Goals and Objectives for the Green Team through December 31, 2014 are established as follows:

Mission:

The Princeton Green Team Advisory Committee will advise the Mayor and Princeton Council on ways to improve municipal operations with "Green" initiatives that are economically and environmentally sound.

Goals:

Submit a report and recommendations to the Mayor and Princeton Council to include:

1. Status of the certification process for certification under Sustainable Jersey; and
2. A report on the success, challenges or problems with creating a "greener" municipal operation.

Objectives:

1. Collaborate with Princeton Municipality employees, service providers, other governmental agencies and organizations focused on sustainability such as Sustainable Princeton to share resource information and ideas consistent with the Mission of the Green Team.
2. Encourage participation of all employees to solicit ideas on green initiatives.
3. Research and analyze green initiatives that make practical environmental and financial sense.
4. Develop strategies for sustainable green initiatives in municipal operations.
