RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of Princeton pursuant to *N.J.S.A. 40A:14-118* has created and established the Princeton Police Department; and

WHEREAS, Section 26-3 of the "Code of the Borough of Princeton, New Jersey, 1974", as amended, has established a line of authority relating to the police function for Princeton; and

WHEREAS, Section 26-3 of said Code designates, as required by law, the Administrator as the "appropriate authority" to work directly with the Princeton Police Department to ensure the efficient and routine day to day operations of said Department; and

WHEREAS, said Administrator has coordinated with the Police Department in preparing Rules and Regulations for said Department and pursuant to Rule 1:1.2 of said Rules and Regulations is prepared to approve, adopt and promulgate for the Department said rules and regulations as now authorized by Section 26-3, as amended; and

WHEREAS, the Administrator has provided to the Mayor and Council said Rules and Regulations for the Princeton Police Department, said Rules and Regulations being attached hereto as Exhibit and made a part hereof so that the governing body will be informed and the citizens of Princeton made aware of the terms and contents of said Rules and Regulations; and

WHEREAS, as a part of the policy of transparency adopted by the Mayor and Council, said governing body wishes to publicly present, discuss and adopt, to the extent permitted by law, said Rules and Regulations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of Princeton as follows:

1. The Princeton Police Department Rules and Regulations as referenced herein above to be effective January 1, 2013 as approved by the Administrator as the Municipal "Appropriate Authority" pursuant to *N.J.S.A. 40A:14-118* are hereby reviewed, further promulgated and adopted by the Mayor and Council of Princeton.
2. A Certified True Copy of this Resolution together with the Princeton Police Department Rules and Regulations shall be posted in the Princeton Police Department.
