

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING
PARKING REGULATIONS ON A
PORTION OF ALEXANDER
STREET AND AMENDING THE
"CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF
PRINCETON, NEW JERSEY,
1968".**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of Princeton as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 11, Article II, Division 2. Parking Restricted of the "Code of the Township of Princeton, New Jersey, 1968" is amended by adding thereto a NEW Section 11-11.3 and shall read as follows:

Sec. 11-11.3 Same – 8:00 A.M. to 6:00 P.M. - EXCEPTIONS

No person shall park a vehicle on the following streets or parts of streets between the hours of 8:00 A.M. and 6:00 P.M. for a period of more than two (2) hours except for vehicles which are owned or operated by existing commercial properties or their employees where said properties have inadequate onsite parking as determined by the Municipal Engineer. Said properties may obtain from Princeton a parking permit from the Clerk's Office to permit parking for more than two (2) hours.

Alexander Street, west side, beginning at a point two hundred fifty-three feet north of the center line of Faculty Road and proceeding north to a point seven hundred ten feet from said center line of Faculty Road.

Alexander Street, east side, beginning at a point three hundred thirty-eight feet north of the northerly curb line of Faculty Road and proceeding north to a point six hundred forty-eight feet from said northerly curb line of Faculty Road.

Section 2. Section 11-12 of said Code which establishes no parking zones within Princeton is amended concerning Alexander Street to read as follows ([bracketed] material deleted; underlined material new):

[*Alexander Street*, east side, beginning at a point three hundred forty feet from the northerly line of Faculty Road and proceeding therefrom to a point four hundred seventy-six feet from said northerly line of Faculty Road, beginning again at a point five hundred forty-five feet from the northerly line of Faculty Road and proceeding therefrom a point five hundred seventy-seven feet from said northerly line of Faculty Road, beginning at a point one thousand two hundred fifty-two feet from the northerly line of Faculty Road and proceeding therefrom to a point one thousand four hundred twenty-five feet from said northerly line of Faculty Road and finally beginning again at a point sixteen hundred and ninety-five feet from the northerly line of Faculty Road and proceeding therefrom to a point one thousand seven hundred and ninety feet from said northerly line of Faculty Road.]

Alexander Street, east side, beginning at the northerly line of Faculty Road proceeding north a distance of three hundred and thirty-eight feet.

Alexander Street, east side, from the southerly line of Faculty Road a distance of one hundred and seventy-five feet south.

Alexander Street, west side, from a point opposite the center of the intersection of Faculty Road to a point two hundred and fifty-three feet northerly and to a point one hundred and fifty-five feet southerly.

Alexander Street, west side, between the municipal boundary line of the township and a point three hundred sixty-five feet south of such boundary line, as measured along Alexander Street and

between the intersection of West Drive and a point one thousand one hundred feet north of West Drive, as measured along Alexander Street.

[*Alexander Street*, east side, beginning at a point three hundred forty feet from the northerly line of Faculty Road and proceeding therefrom to a point four hundred seventy-six feet from said northerly line of Faculty Road; beginning again at a point five hundred forty-five feet from the northerly line of Faculty Road; and finally beginning at a point one thousand two hundred fifty feet from the northerly line of Faculty Road and proceeding therefrom to a point one thousand four hundred thirty-six feet from said northerly line of Faculty Road.]

Section 3. Regulatory and warning signs shall be posted to implement these parking regulations.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication as required by law.
