**RE:** 2014 MUNICIPAL ALLIANCE Extension

**DATE:** October 31, 2013

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We are in the process of completing the 2014 Application for Funding Municipal Alliances to Mercer County. The Governor's Council is transitioning the grant term from a calendar year to a fiscal year starting July 1, 2014. This requires an extension to the current contract, originally ending December 31, 2013, which will now be extended until June 30, 2014. Total grant funds available to the Princeton Alcohol and Drug Alliance (PADA) through this extension are \$14,010. The attached resolution must be approved by Council to complete the application process.

PADA is a citizens group with broad community representation whose mission is to further awareness of substance abuse issues and reduce alcohol, tobacco, and other drug use through prevention programs and educational outreach activities in Princeton. PADA programs include the Corner House Leadership Institute, the Teen Advisory Group (TAG), the Senior Learning Series, and Growing-up Accepted as an Individual in America (GAIA).

Fiscal Grant Extension January 1, 2014 to June 30, 2014

**Resolution**

**WHEREAS**, the Governor's Council on Alcoholism and Drug Abuse established the Municipal Alliances for the Prevention of Alcoholism and Drug Abuse in 1989 to educate and engage residents, local government and law enforcement officials, schools, nonprofit organizations, the faith community, parents, youth and other allies in efforts to prevent alcoholism and drug abuse in communities throughout New Jersey.

**WHEREAS**, The Mayor and Council of Princeton, County of Mercer, State of New Jersey reorganizes that the abuse of alcohol and drugs is a serious problem in our society amongst persons of all ages; and therefore has an established Municipal Alliance Committee; and,

**WHEREAS**, Princeton was approved for a Municipal Alliance grant for the January 1, 2013 through December 31, 2103 grant term; and

**WHEREAS**, the Governor's Council on Alcoholism and Drug Abuse has extended the 2013 grant term until June 30, 2014, in order to transition the grant to a fiscal year rather than calendar year cycle; and

**WHEREAS**, funding has been made available to Princeton Alcoholism and Drug Alliance (PADA) in the of 50% of its approved 2013 grant total for the six-month extension period of January 1, 2014 to June 30, 2014, contingent upon meting the 25% Cash Match and 75% In-Kind Match grant requirement for the extension funding.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE ITRESOLVED** That the Mayor and Council of Princeton does hereby authorize the submission of the grant extension for the Princeton Alcohol and Drug Alliance (PADA) Municipal Alliance grant in the amount of:

**WHEREAS**, the County of Mercer entered into a **SHARED SERVICE AGREEMENT** with Princeton for the provision of Municipal Alliance programs for the period of January 1, 2013 to December 31, 2013 in the amount of \$28,020.00, as per Resolution #2013-209, adopted April 11, 2013; and,

**WHEREAS**, an **AMENDMENT** is required to the original **SHARED SERVICE AGREEMENT** to reflect an increase in the amount of \$14,010.00 increasing the new **SHARED SERVICE AGREEMENT** total to \$42,030.00, as a result of an increase in services by the Governor's Council of Alcoholism and Drug Abuse, as well as a required 6-month extension to the original Shared Service Agreement to be extended to June 30, 2014;

NOW THEREFORE, the parties do mutually agree as follows:

- A. The original **SHARED SERVICE AGREEMENT** be and is hereby **AMENDED** to reflect additional funding in the amount of \$14,010.00 for a new Agreement ceiling of \$42,030.00.

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
