WHEREAS, On February 2, 1946, the citizens of Princeton were saddened and grieved by the death of Officer Walter Harris, who died in the line of duty; and

WHEREAS, Officer Harris was a very capable, honest and trustworthy policeman, faithful in the performance of his duties; and

WHEREAS, Officer Harris has been honored by having his name placed on the National Law Enforcement Memorial in Washington, D.C. among the names of officers from all over the United States who have made the ultimate sacrifice for the safety and well-being of others;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Liz Lempert, Mayor of Princeton, and on behalf of Princeton Council do hereby proclaim February 2, 2014 as

Officer Walter Harris Day

In Princeton, County of Mercer, State of New Jersey and request that Princeton Municipal Building flags fly at half-mast and all police personnel that are on duty that day drape their badges with mourning bands; and

FURTHER, that this Proclamation be made a part of the official minutes and that a certified copy of this expression of our recognition be delivered to the family of Officer Harris.
