RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING THE
Parks Commission Task Force

WHEREAS, Princeton's system of parks and open spaces, totaling over 500 acres, provides a significant environmental and recreational resource for the community; and

WHEREAS, maintenance of these parks is currently a joint effort among the Public Works Department and the Recreation Department, with help from volunteers and non-profit organizations, and of particular interest to the Shade Tree Commission and the Environmental Commission; and

WHEREAS, a Parks Commission could aid with developing, maintaining, and preserving these parks, and with leveraging volunteers;

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved that the Mayor and Council hereby establish the Parks Commission Task Force in order to make recommendations about the creation of a Parks Commission, its membership, mission and responsibilities.
