

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING  
SECTION 2-116 OF THE CODE OF  
THE TOWNSHIP OF PRINCETON  
CONCERNING THE ANIMAL  
CONTROL ADVISORY  
COMMITTEE**

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of Princeton as follows:

**Section 1.** Chapter 2 (Administration) of the “Code of the Township of Princeton, New Jersey, 1968” is amended to read as follows:

**Sec. 2-116. Animal Control Advisory Committee**

There is hereby established an Animal Control Advisory Committee consisting of three {two} residents (“citizen members”), at least one of whom has expertise in animal biology or control; the Animal Control Officer; the Administrator or his or her designee; and a non-voting liaison from the governing body. The citizen members shall be appointed for three year terms except that the initial appointments shall be for a one year term, a two year term and a three year term.

Additions in text are indicated by underlining, deletions by {brackets} except that underlined catchwords are not necessarily additions.

The foregoing ordinance was introduced at a meeting of the Mayor and Council of Princeton held on September 23, 2013 and will be further considered for final passage after a public hearing thereon at a meeting of said Mayor and Council to be held at the Princeton Municipal Complex, Witherspoon Hall, 400 Witherspoon Street on October 14, 2013 which begins at 7:00 p.m.
