

**RESOLUTION 2014-R
OF THE MAYOR AND GOVERNING BODY
OF PRINCETON APPROVING AN EMERGENCY TEMPORARY
APPROPRIATION FOR THE 2014 AFFORDABLE HOUSING FUND BUDGET**

WHEREAS, an emergent 2014 condition has arisen with respect to the 2014 Affordable Housing Fund Budget, due to the lack of an adopted 2014 Affordable Housing Fund Budget and no adequate provision has been made in the 2014 temporary budget for appropriations for the next several months, and N.J.S.A. 40A:4-20 provides for the creation of an emergency temporary appropriation for the purpose above mentioned, and

WHEREAS, the total emergency temporary resolutions adopted in the year 2014 pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 96, P.L. 1951 (N.J.S.A. 40A:4-20) including the original 2013 temporary budget and this resolution total \$65,400.00

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED (not less than two-thirds of all the members thereof affirmatively concurring) that in accordance with the provisions of N.J.S.A. 40A:4-20:

1. An emergency temporary appropriation be and the same is hereby made as per the attached appropriations in the amount of \$65,400.00
2. That the emergency temporary appropriation has been provided for in the 2013 Budget under the said title.
3. That one certified copy of this resolution be filed with the Director of the Division of Local Government Services.
