

AN ORDINANCE BY THE TOWNSHIP OF PRINCETON, COUNTY OF MERCER, STATE OF NEW JERSEY REGARDING THE POLICE DEPARTMENT AND AMENDING THE "CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PRINCETON, NEW JERSEY, 1968".

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Princeton as follows:

1. Section 15-4 of the "Code of the Township of Princeton, New Jersey, 1968"

(hereinafter "the Code") is hereby amended to read as follows:

Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:14-118, the township committee is hereby designated as the appropriate authority with the power to adopt and amend from time to time such rules and regulations for the government of the police department and for the discipline of its members in a manner consistent with the law and this chapter. The rules and regulations may include the delegation to the chief of police of power to adopt such rules, regulations, procedures and orders as shall be deemed to promote the efficiency of the department. Any such rules, regulation, procedure or order of the chief of police may be modified or annulled by the township committee.

The township committee hereby appoints the township administrator to act as liaison between the chief of police and the township committee on day-to-day operations of the police department.

2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication as provided for by law.

The foregoing ordinance was introduced at a meeting of Princeton Township Committee held on May 10, 2010 and will be further considered for final passage after a public hearing thereon at a meeting of said Township Committee to be held at the Princeton Township Municipal Complex, 400 Witherspoon Street on May 24, 2010 which begins at 7:00 p.m.
