There may be a time when an emergency takes place in our community due to an airborne chemical release, power outage, storm, water emergency or other hazardous condition.

Vital information may need to be distributed to residents and businesses in a rapid fashion.

Telephone Notification

Princeton has acquired the services of ***Community Alert Network (CAN)***. ***Community Alert Network*** has a computerized telephone system that can target a general township wide area or a very specific area and send messages to over 13,000 phones per hour. If there is an emergency that may be a risk to Princeton, the Office of Emergency Management (OEM) will activate the ***CAN*** system.

This form is intended for all new homes and businesses owners, renters or tenants. Please complete this form and re-direct it to the Office of Emergency Management AS SOON AS POSSIBLE Your physical address and telephone numbers will be incorporated into the Emergency Telephone database.

*“There has been a water main break north of Princeton. The public is advised to boil all drinking water for a period of at least one-minute prior to drinking. Please turn on your Radio/TV for further information OR Additional information can be found at the Princeton Web Site or at 921-3508 for a pre-recorded message. **Do not call 9-1-1 unless you have an emergency.**”*
