Corner House Board - Provides recommendations to the Mayor and Council concerning the operations and administration of Corner House, the municipal treatment and

prevention agency addressing substance abuse and education programs associated with same.

Environmental Commission – Advises Mayor and Council on the development and use of natural resources and makes recommendations concerning open space preservation, water resource management and air pollution.

Historic Preservation Commission - Promotes historic preservation, recommends designation of historic properties, and prepares surveys of historic sites. Advises and assists the Planning Board and the Board of Adjustment by reviewing and reporting on development applications and preservation plans in locally designated historic districts and buffer zones. Makes recommendations to the Planning Board on the Historic Preservation Element of the Master Plan and the general protection of the community's heritage.

Princeton Planning Board - Adjudicates land use applications in accordance with state & local regulations. Prepares & revises Master Plan to balance changing needs while preserving community values. Recommends revisions to the land use code. Promotes dialogue on planning & community issues.

Recreation Committee - Plans, develops, administers, manages and controls public recreation areas, projects and facilities.
