Plastics marked with either #1 or #2 recycle symbol (lids are ok)

Plastic Beverage Bottles, Milk Jugs, Detergent & Shampoo containers (lids are ok)

Glass Food & Beverage Jars/Bottles

Clean Paper

Clean Newspaper

Clean Cardboard (OR Green Organic)

Junk Mail

Envelopes (It's ok to leave windows in)

Cereal Boxes (remove liners)

Cookie & Cracker Boxes (remove liners)

Dry Soap Boxes

Shoe Boxes

Juice & Beverage Cartons including Juice Boxes

Stationary (No metallic foil)

Computer & Copier Paper

Pet Food Cans

Telephone Directories & Paperback Books

Hardcover Books with the covers removed

Brown Paper Bags (OR Green Organic)

Break down all large boxes.
