## **BUS SHELTERS PROJECT**

In an on-going effort to enhance Princeton's alternate mode of transportation program, 3 existing bus shelters will be replaced and 5 new bus shelters will be installed at the following locations:



- Route 206 (Stockton Street) at Edgerstoune Road – bus shelter replacement;
- Harrison Street southbound at Franklin Avenue – bus shelter replacement;
- Harrison Street southbound at Hamilton Avenue – bus shelter replacement;
- Harrison Street – 2 new bus shelters;
- Princeton Community Village – new bus shelter;
- Witherspoon Street – 2 new bus shelters.

This is a collaborative project between Princeton and NJ Transit.

Beginning the week of April 18<sup>th</sup>, weather permitting, Princeton's sidewalk contractor, T. Fiotakis Construction LLC, will start the concrete pad installation at the aforementioned locations. NJ Transit will follow with the installation of the bus shelters. Pedestrian access will be maintained for the duration of the work.
