IMPORTANT NOTICE REGARDING EDGEHILL STREET IMPROVEMENTS

On Monday, October 26th and Tuesday, October 27th, weather permitting, the contractor plans to finish the installation and resetting of the bluestone sidewalk, and install top soil and seeding. On Wednesday, October 28th and Thursday, October 29th, weather permitting, the contractor will mill and install base pavement on Edgehill Street. In order to provide for this work, Edgehill Street will be closed between Mercer Street and Stockton Street (Route 206) during the hours of 7 am to approximately 6 pm. The final paving is tentatively scheduled for Friday, October 30th. Additional notice will be provided.

We request that you move your vehicle prior to commencement of milling and pavement operation, 7 am, to an alternate close-by location, such as Library Place or Hibben Road. Please use the previously provided overnight parking waiver placard (if you need additional placard, please contact Rich Decker) for on-street overnight parking. You will be able to move your car into your driveway at the end of the working day, once the road is opened to traffic.

Please have your organics curbside on Tuesday night (10/27) for an early pick-up on Wednesday (10/28). Provisions will be made for mail delivery and emergency services vehicles. In the event of inclement weather, the work will proceed on the following day.
