

Edgehill Street Improvements - Update 10-16-15

Starting on Tuesday, October 20th, and through Friday, October 23rd, weather permitting, the contractor plans to reset and install the bluestone sidewalk. **In order to accommodate this work, Edgehill Street will be closed to through traffic during the work hours of 7:00 am to 6:00 pm on weekdays. On-street parking will also be suspended during work hours to permit safe movement of construction equipment and residential traffic.** In the event of inclement weather, work will proceed the following business day. Looking ahead, the milling and base pavement installation work is planned for the following week.

Provisions will be made for emergency services vehicles and for continued services such as brush and leaf collection, mail delivery, garbage and recycling pick-up. The road will be reopened to full two-way traffic and parking at the end of each work day.
