IMPORTANT NOTICE REGARDING GREAT ROAD & MOUNTAIN AVENUE TRAFFIC SIGNAL WORK

On Friday, December 16th, weather permitting, Foggia Trinity Electric, a subcontractor to S. Brothers, plans to activate the traffic signal at the intersection of Great Road and Mountain Avenue.

Most of the work will be off-road during the hours of 8 AM and approximately 3 PM, however minor traffic interruptions may result as adjustments to the signals are made. **No road closures are anticipated at this time. Should the work necessitate a road closure, additional notice will be provided.**

Starting Friday, the signals will be set in flash mode for 5 calendar days. Motorists on Great Road, in both directions, will experience a flashing yellow "caution", while motorists approaching Great Road on Mountain Avenue will experience a flashing red "stop". Signage and an electronic message board will be in place on Great Road during the flashing operations to inform the drivers of the traffic pattern change. **On December 21st, following 5 days of signal set on flashing mode, the signal will be fully operational with Red-Yellow-Green phasing.**

Should inclement weather occur, the work will be rescheduled at a later date.

Residents are advised to use caution when driving within the work area and allow additional time for travel.
