Dear Honorable Mayors Lempert and Hsueh:

Please be advised that on or about **Monday, August 15, 2016**, milling and resurfacing work will begin on **Harrison Street (CR 629) between U.S. Route 1 to the Delaware and Raritan Canal Bridge**. Mercer County anticipates that this work will take approximately ten (10) working days, weather permitting.

Construction will take place from approximately 9:00 AM to 3:00 PM, weekdays only. During this time, Harrison Street will be closed to through traffic. Motorists will be directed to use Faculty Road and Washington Road. During construction, emergency access and limited access to local residents and businesses would be permitted. Full, unrestricted access would be permitted during non-working hours.

Mercer County staff will post signs prior to the start date advising motorists of upcoming road work. Would you or a member of your staff please coordinate and notify affected local residents and businesses, emergency response and school transportation officials and other pertinent groups, agencies or organizations that may be temporarily inconvenienced due to construction.
