IMPORTANT NOTICE

The Municipality of Princeton has contracted with Top Line Construction Corporation of Somerville, New Jersey to complete improvements to Mount Lucas Road between Stuart Road East and Cherry Hill Road. The work will involve some storm drainage improvement, sidewalk and pathway widening/reconstruction, belgian block curb installation and pavement reconstruction. NJ American Water Company has also contracted with CRJ Contracting to replace water main and services on Mount Lucas Road between Laurel Road and Cherry Hill Road and Ewing Street and Jefferson Street.

Work hours are generally from 7:00 am to 5:00 pm, Monday Through Friday. Mount Lucas Road will be closed except for local traffic only during work hours, and will reopen at the end of each work day. Residents are advised to use caution when driving within the road closure area and allow additional time for travel. Provisions will be made for emergency services vehicles and for continued services such as brush collection, mail delivery, garbage and recycling pick-up.

On Wednesday, April 22, Top Line Construction will begin work, weather permitting, at the northern end of the project. Storm sewer installation is scheduled to begin on April 23 at the Stuart Road East intersection, and then work will proceed south toward Ewing Street. Beginning Thursday, April 23, Mount Lucas Road will be closed to through traffic from Ewing Street north to Stuart Road East during work hours until further notice.

On Monday, April 27, CRJ Contracting is scheduled to begin water main replacement between Laurel Road and Cherry Hill Road. Beginning on Monday, April 27, Mount Lucas Road will be closed to through traffic from Laurel Road to Cherry Hill Road during working hours until further notice.

In the event of inclement weather, work will proceed the following day, excluding Saturdays and Sundays. There may be times when access to your driveway will be closed; we will endeavor to provide 24-hour notice when this will occur.
