IMPORTANT NOTICE REGARDING MOUNT LUCAS ROADWAY WORK

ROADWAY IMPROVEMENT WORK BETWEEN JEFFERSON ROAD AND CHERRY HILL ROAD AND BETWEEN JEFFERSON ROAD AND EWING STREET

On Monday, September 14th, and through Friday, September 18th, weather permitting, the contractor plans to finish the remaining dry-laid stone wall work and grading as required for the paved pathways on northbound side of Mount Lucas Road between Jefferson Road and Cherry Hill Road. Also, the contractor plans to install the remaining sections of Belgian block curb along with the remaining concrete sidewalk slabs and handicapped curb ramps. **In order to provide for this work, Mount Lucas Road will be closed to through traffic from Jefferson Road to Cherry Hill Road and between Ewing Street and Jefferson Road during working hours of 7 am to approximately 6 pm.**

Should inclement weather occur, the work will proceed the following business day. Mount Lucas Road will reopen at the end of each work day. Residents are advised to use caution when driving within the road closure area and allow additional time for travel. Provisions will be made for emergency services vehicles and for continued services such as brush collection, mail delivery, garbage and recycling pick-up.
