### **IMPORTANT NOTICE REGARDING MERCER ROAD WORK BETWEEN LOVERS LANE AND QUAKER ROAD**

On Wednesday, August 3<sup>rd</sup>, weather permitting, S Brothers plans to install the final surface course of bituminous pavement on Mercer Road between Lovers Lane and Quaker Road. **While this work is proceeding, Mercer Road will be closed between Lovers Lane and Quaker Road during the work hours of 7 am to approximately 5 pm.** We request that all properties which have direct driveway access to Mercer Road within the project limits, including properties on Greenhouse Drive, park in a legal parking space on a nearby side street or in the parking area of Marquand Park on Lovers Lane, and walk to/from your home before and during the paving installation. If parking overnight, please use the parking waiver placard for on-street overnight parking attached to your paper notice delivered to your door. You can move your vehicle after the road has been reopened later that evening. Provisions will be made for emergency services vehicles. Please refrain from any pedestrian foot traffic across the new pavement during work hours, as the pavement surface is very hot and susceptible to marring.

The organics pick-up on Mercer Road within the closure area has been rescheduled for Thursday, August 4<sup>th</sup>. Should the organics not be picked up on Thursday, please keep the can curbside and notify the staff member listed below so another pick-up can be scheduled for Friday, August 5<sup>th</sup>.

The road will be reopened to full two-way traffic at the end of the work day.
