IMPORTANT NOTICE

Dear Ewing Street Neighborhood Residents:

Beginning on Tuesday, March 26, 2013, weather permitting, Top Line Construction, Princeton's Contractor, will continue milling the existing roadway and installing the base pavement for Ewing Street. The work is scheduled to start near the North Harrison Street intersection and progress toward Valley Road. The work is planned to begin at 7:00 a.m. each workday and is anticipated to be completed by the end of the day Monday, April 1st, weather permitting. Top Line Construction will not be working on Friday, March 29, 2013.

Residents are asked to remove vehicles from their driveways prior to the start of work each day – either the night before or before 7:00 a.m. Residents will not be permitted to park vehicles in the construction area of Ewing Street due to the work being performed on the roadway. Residents will be allowed to park on Cuyler Road and Hillside Road where the work is not taking place. Residents will have access to their driveways at the end of each day. **In the event of inclement weather, the work will proceed on the following day.**


Work hours will be between 7:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. Provisions will be made for continued services such as mail delivery, garbage and recycling pick-up.

You will receive an additional notice prior to the paving of the driveways damaged during the curbing installation and if this base paving work is required to be extended.
