## **IMPORTANT NOTICE REGARDING MOORE STREET AND WILLOW STREET**

**On Tuesday, July 22, 2014, weather permitting, the contractor will begin milling the existing pavement and installing new base pavement on Moore Street from Nassau Street to Franklin Avenue.** The work is planned to begin on Tuesday morning and is anticipated to be completed by the end of the day Wednesday, July 23rd, weather permitting. In the event of inclement weather, the work will proceed on the following work day.

Moore Street and Willow Street residents are asked to remove vehicles from their driveways Monday night or early Tuesday morning, prior to the start of work. Residents will not be permitted to park vehicles in the construction areas of Moore Street due to the work being performed on the roadway. If you do not anticipate needing your vehicle during work hours of 7:00 am – 6:00 pm, there is no need to move your vehicle from your driveway.

Residents will be allowed to park on Madison Street, Spruce Street, Hamilton Avenue, Houghton Street and Hawthorne Avenue or other non-metered, legal parking spaces where work is not taking place. Affected Moore Street residents are advised to display a yellow parking placard in their vehicles. Free overnight parking is available at the following locations:

- The Spring Street Garage (upon validation by parking garage staff) for those vehicles displaced by construction. In order to use this opportunity, please email the following information to Bill Moraski, Parking Superintendent, at [bmoraski@princetonnj.gov](mailto:bmoraski@princetonnj.gov): your name, address, cell phone number, and make / model / license plate number. If you need to park your car on the street overnight, please contact Deanna Stockton, [dstockton@princetonnj.gov](mailto:dstockton@princetonnj.gov), to obtain a temporary parking placard, which must be placed on the dashboard of the driver's side front windshield.
- Saint Paul School lot. If you utilize this option, please adhere to the following conditions:
  - Park behind the school buildings, not the church;
  - Remove your vehicle by 7:00 am; and
  - Place a note or the yellow parking placard on your vehicle's dashboard indicating where you reside and that you are displaced due to construction.

**The Park Place east parking lot will only be accessible from Park Place via Vandeventer Avenue during work hours for the duration of the milling and paving work on Moore Street.**

**Moore Street and Willow Street residents will have access to their driveways at the end of each day.** You will receive an additional notice prior to the final paving of the roadway and if

this base paving work is required to be extended. **Please note, the Moore Street / Wiggins-Hamilton intersection will remain in a milled condition until the final top course of pavement is installed.**

We are working with the service providers to have the collection of garbage, recycling and organics on all of the affected roads take place on your regularly scheduled day between the hours of 6:30 am and 7:00 am. Please place your bins out at the curb by 6:30 am. Please do not place brush or logs for collection out at the curb; the next collection cycle does not begin until August.
