IMPORTANT NOTICE REGARDING MOUNT LUCAS ROADWAY WORK

ROADWAY IMPROVEMENT WORK BETWEEN JEFFERSON ROAD AND EWING STREET

Continuing next week, Tuesday, May 26th through Friday, May 29th, weather permitting, the contractor, Top Line Construction Corp., will install Belgian block curb on the northbound side of Mount Lucas Road between Jefferson Road and Ewing Street. While this work is proceeding, Mount Lucas Road will be closed between Jefferson Road and Ewing Street during the hours of 7 am to approximately 6 pm, weekdays only. No work will be performed on Memorial Day, May 25th.

ROADWAY IMPROVEMENT WORK BETWEEN STUART ROAD EAST AND EWING STREET

Starting on Tuesday, May 26th, weather and scheduling permitting, pavement will be installed at driveways on northbound side of Mount Lucas Road between Stuart Road East and Ewing Street. Continuing on Wednesday, May 27th, through Friday, May 29th, weather permitting, pavement will be installed for the 8' wide path and driveways on the southbound side of Mount Lucas Road between Stuart Road East and Ewing Street. To provide for this work, Mount Lucas Road will be closed between Stuart Road East and Ewing Street.

The new driveway pavement will need approximately 2 hours to cure after installation. We request that when the paver gets to your driveway, you make accommodations either by moving your vehicle to an alternate close-by location, such as Stuart Road East, a location along Mount Lucas Road where work is not taking place, or obtain permission to park in a neighbor's driveway or yard on the opposite side of the road of where the work is occurring to allow the pavement to cure.

NEW JERSEY AMERICAN WATER MAIN IMPROVEMENT WORK

Continuing on Tuesday, May 26th and through the rest of the week, NJAW will be installing the new fire hydrants between Cherry Hill Road and Laurel Road and between Jefferson Road and Ewing Street. In order to provide for this work, Mount Lucas Road will be closed from Cherry Hill Road to Jefferson Street to through traffic during working hours of 7 am to 5 pm, Tuesday through Friday.

Mount Lucas Road will reopen at the end of each work day. Residents are advised to use caution when driving within the road closure area and allow additional time for travel. Provisions will be made for emergency services vehicles and for continued services such as brush collection, mail delivery, garbage and recycling pick-up.
