IMPORTANT NOTICE REGARDING MOUNT LUCAS ROADWAY WORK

ROADWAY IMPROVEMENT WORK BETWEEN JEFFERSON ROAD AND EWING STREET

Continuing next week, Monday, June 1st through Friday, June 5th, weather permitting, the contractor, Top Line Construction Corp., will continue with curb work, drainage work, and the installation of concrete sidewalk and driveway aprons on the southbound side of Mount Lucas Road between Jefferson Road and Ewing Street. While this work is proceeding, Mount Lucas Road will be closed between Jefferson Road and Ewing Street during the hours of 7 am to approximately 6 pm, weekdays only. When concrete sidewalk and the concrete driveway apron are installed across your driveway, access to your driveway will be prohibited for the next 72 hours. Please park on the side of the street, away from where the work is occurring, or work with a neighbor across the street to share their driveway. We will notify you when access is restored to your driveway.

ROADWAY IMPROVEMENT WORK BETWEEN STUART ROAD EAST AND EWING STREET

Starting on Monday, June 1st, and through the rest of the week, weather permitting, the Stuart Road East intersection will be milled and base pavement will be installed between Redding Circle and Ewing Street. To provide for this work, Mount Lucas Road will be closed between Stuart Road East and Ewing Street.

NEW JERSEY AMERICAN WATER MAIN IMPROVEMENT WORK

The water company has completed the main replacement. They are in the process of testing the new water main next week, Monday, June 1st through Friday, June 5th. No road closures are anticipated for this work.

Mount Lucas Road will reopen at the end of each work day. Residents are advised to use caution when driving within the road closure area and allow additional time for travel. Provisions will be made for emergency services vehicles and for continued services such as brush collection, mail delivery, garbage and recycling pick-up.
