IMPORTANT NOTICE REGARDING MOUNT LUCAS ROADWAY WORK

ROADWAY IMPROVEMENT WORK BETWEEN STUART ROAD EAST AND EWING STREET

On Monday, June 15th, weather permitting, the contractor will be reconstructing a sanitary sewer manhole just north of Redding Circle. The work will take approximately 1 business day to complete. While this work is proceeding, one lane closure will be in effect on Mount Lucas Road in this location north of Redding Circle during the hours of 7 am to approximately 6 pm. Should inclement weather occur, the work will proceed the following business day.

ROADWAY IMPROVEMENT WORK BETWEEN JEFFERSON ROAD AND EWING STREET

Continuing next week, Monday, June 15th through Friday, June 19th, weather permitting, Top Line Construction Corp., will top soil and seed the disturbed grass areas along both sides of the road. In addition, the remaining concrete sidewalk and driveway aprons are planned to be installed along the southbound side of Mount Lucas Road. In order to provide for this work, Mount Lucas Road will be closed to through traffic from Jefferson Road to Ewing Street during working hours of 7 am to approximately 6 pm. When concrete sidewalk and the concrete driveway apron are installed across your driveway, access to your driveway will be prohibited for the next 72 hours. Please park on the side of the street, away from where the work is occurring, or work with a neighbor across the street to share their driveway. We will notify you when access is restored to your driveway.

ROADWAY IMPROVEMENT WORK BETWEEN JEFFERSON ROAD AND LAUREL ROAD

Beginning on Wednesday, June 17th, weather permitting and through the rest of the week, Top Line Construction is tentatively scheduled to install curb on both sides of Mount Lucas Road, starting at Jefferson Road and continuing south to Laurel Road. In order to provide for this work, Mount Lucas Road will be closed to through traffic from Jefferson Road to Laurel Road during working hours of 7 am to approximately 6 pm. When curbing is installed across your driveway, access to your driveway will be prohibited for the next 48 hours. Please park on the side of the street, away from where the work is occurring, or work with a neighbor across the street to share their driveway. We will notify you when access is restored to your driveway. Please do not park at the designated parking lot spaces in the Redding Circle neighborhood.

NEW JERSEY AMERICAN WATER MAIN AND SERVICES IMPROVEMENT WORK

Starting Wednesday, June 17th through Friday, June 19th, weather and workload permitting, CRJ Construction will return to perform minor work on the water main just north of the Cherry Hill Road intersection. Following completion of this work and the testing of the new water main, CRJ Construction plans to begin the replacement of house services within the public right-of-way between Jefferson Road and Ewing Street. Further notice will be provided once the scheduling of this work is confirmed. While this work is proceeding, Mount Lucas Road will be closed between Cherry Hill Road and Laurel Road during the hours of 7 am to approximately 5 pm, weekdays only.

We understand that some neighbors may have been under the impression that parking meters are intended to be installed as part of this project. Please be advised that the Municipality has no plans to install parking meters on Mount Lucas Road.

Mount Lucas Road will reopen at the end of each work day. Residents are advised to use caution when driving within the road closure area and allow additional time for travel. Provisions will be made for emergency services vehicles and for continued services such as brush collection, mail delivery, garbage and recycling pick-up.
