IMPORTANT NOTICE REGARDING MOUNT LUCAS ROADWAY IMPROVEMENTS WORK BETWEEN JEFFERSON ROAD AND EWING STREET

Tomorrow, August 6th through Friday, August 7th, weather permitting, the contractor will begin milling the existing pavement and installing new base pavement on Mount Lucas Road between Jefferson Road and Ewing Street. While this work is proceeding, Mount Lucas Road will be closed between Jefferson Road and Ewing Street during the hours of 7 am to approximately 6 pm, weekdays only.

We request that you move your vehicle prior to commencement of milling and pavement operation, 7 am, to an alternate close-by location, such as Jefferson Road, Laurel Road or location along Mount Lucas Road between Jefferson Road and Laurel Road where work is not taking place. Please use the attached overnight parking waiver placard (attached to the paper notice delivered to your door) for on-street overnight parking on Jefferson Road. You will be able to move your car into your driveway at the end of the working day, once the road is opened to traffic.

Mount Lucas Road will reopen at the end of each work day. Residents are advised to use caution when driving within the road closure area and allow additional time for travel. Provisions will be made for emergency services vehicles and for continued services such as brush collection, mail delivery, garbage and recycling pick-up.
