IMPORTANT NOTICE REGARDING MOUNT LUCAS ROADWAY WORK

ROADWAY IMPROVEMENT WORK BETWEEN JEFFERSON ROAD AND CHERRY HILL ROAD AND AT THE MOUNT LUCAS ROAD AND EWING STREET INTERSECTION

On Monday, October 5th, weather permitting, the contractor plans to finish the paving of the driveway on Ewing Street at the northeast corner of the Mount Lucas Road and Ewing Street intersection and complete miscellaneous work between Laurel Road and Cherry Hill Road in preparation for paving work. In order to provide for this work, Mount Lucas Road will be closed to through traffic from Jefferson Road to Cherry Hill Road and Laurel Road between Mount Lucas Road and Jefferson Road during working hours of 7 am to approximately 6 pm. While the paving driveway work is proceeding near the intersection of Mount Lucas Road and Ewing Street, the intersection will remain open, although there may be some interruption of traffic when the driveway is being paved. Please allow for extra travel time and proceed with caution through this intersection. The businesses located on Mount Lucas Road closest to Cherry Hill Road will remain accessible.

The contractor plans to install final paving on Mount Lucas Road from Ewing Street to Cherry Hill Road on Tuesday, October 6th and through Friday, October 9th, weather permitting. Additional notice will be provided.

Should inclement weather occur, the work will proceed the following business day. Mount Lucas Road will reopen at the end of each work day. Residents are advised to use caution when driving within the road closure area and allow additional time for travel. Provisions will be made for emergency services vehicles and for continued services such as brush collection, mail delivery, garbage and recycling pick-up.
