## IMPORTANT NOTICE REGARDING MOUNT LUCAS ROAD WORK

The Municipality of Princeton has contracted with Top Line Construction Corporation to construct roadway, sidewalk, pathway, curbing and storm sewer improvements on Mount Lucas Road between Cherry Hill Road and Stuart Road East. On Friday, April 10, 2015, weather permitting, Top Line Construction will be conducting nighttime work that will take place at the Mount Lucas/Cherry Hill Road intersection to replace an existing storm drain pipe. In order to provide for this work, the Mount Lucas Road / Cherry Hill Road intersection will be closed to through traffic during the work hours of 8:00 pm and 6:00 am on Friday night. Should severe weather conditions be encountered, this work will be rescheduled for the same work hours on Friday, April 17, 2015.

During this nighttime construction, the following Mount Lucas Road detours will be in effect for through traffic:

- Northbound traffic will be detoured onto Route 206 at Terhune Road.
- Southbound traffic will be detoured onto Terhune Road via Jefferson Road.
