IMPORTANT NOTICE REGARDING MOUNT LUCAS ROADWAY WORK

ROADWAY IMPROVEMENT WORK BETWEEN JEFFERSON ROAD AND CHERRY HILL ROAD AND AT THE INTERSECTION OF MOUNT LUCAS ROAD AND STUART ROAD EAST

On Monday, August 24th, and through Friday, August 28th, weather permitting, the contractor will continue with the dry-laid stone wall installation as required for the paved pathway on northbound side of Mount Lucas Road between Jefferson Road and Cherry Hill Road; on the west side of the Mount Lucas Road and at the Stuart Road East intersection. Also, on Wednesday, August 26th, the contractor plans to continue with installing the remaining sections of Belgian block curb and concrete handicapped curb ramps. In order to provide for this work, Mount Lucas Road will be closed to through traffic from Jefferson Road to Cherry Hill Road during working hours of 7 am to approximately 6 pm. When work is taking place on Mount Lucas Road at Stuart Road East, Mount Lucas Road will be closed to through traffic from Poor Farm Road to Ewing Street. Redding Circle will remain accessible from Ewing Street.

ROADWAY IMPROVEMENT WORK BETWEEN JEFFERSON ROAD AND EWING STREET AND AT REDDING CIRCLE AND MOUNT LUCAS ROAD INTERSECTION

On Wednesday, August 26th, and through Friday, August 28th, weather permitting, the contractor will continue with the remaining sections of Belgian block curb, concrete sidewalk slabs and concrete handicapped curb ramps. In order to provide for this work, Mount Lucas Road will be closed to through traffic from Jefferson Road to Ewing Street during working hours of 7 am to approximately 6 pm. When work is taking place on Mount Lucas Road at Redding Circle, Mount Lucas Road will be closed to through traffic from Poor Farm Road to Ewing Street. Redding Circle will remain accessible.

NEW JERSEY AMERICAN WATER MAIN AND SERVICES IMPROVEMENT WORK

On Monday, August 24th, and through Wednesday, August 26th, weather permitting, the New Jersey American Water (NJAW) company's contractor, CRJ Construction, plans to complete the remaining work associated with the new water main on Mount Lucas Road between Cherry Hill Road and Laurel Road. In order to provide for this work, Mount Lucas Road will be closed to through traffic from Jefferson Road to Cherry Hill Road during working hours of 7 am to approximately 5 pm. When work is taking place on Mount Lucas Road at Laurel Road, Laurel Road will be closed to through traffic from Mount Lucas Road to Jefferson Road. When work is taking place on Mount Lucas Road at Cherry Hill Road, Cherry Hill Road will be closed from Mount Lucas Road to Route 206 between the hours of 9 am to 3:30 pm.

Should inclement weather occur, the work will proceed the following business day. Mount Lucas Road will reopen at the end of each work day. Residents are advised to use caution when driving within the road closure area and allow additional time for travel. Provisions will be made for emergency services vehicles and for continued services such as brush collection, mail delivery, garbage and recycling pick-up.
