IMPORTANT NOTICE REGARDING MOUNT LUCAS ROADWAY WORK

ROADWAY IMPROVEMENT WORK BETWEEN JEFFERSON ROAD AND CHERRY HILL ROAD AND BETWEEN JEFFERSON ROAD AND EWING STREET

On Monday, September 21st, through Wednesday, September 23rd, weather permitting, the contractor plans to finish the grading of the pathway and removal of pavement at driveway aprons on Mount Lucas Road between Laurel Road and Cherry Hill Road. Also, the contractor plans to finish the remaining concrete work. **In order to provide for this work, Mount Lucas Road will be closed to through traffic from Jefferson Road to Cherry Hill Road during working hours of 7 am to approximately 6 pm.**

On Thursday, September 24th and through Saturday, September 26th, weather permitting, the contractor plans to install pavement on the paved path and at the driveway aprons. Please note the access to your driveway will be prohibited for 24 hours after the paving work is completed. Please park in a legal parking space on the street away from where the work is occurring. You will receive additional notice prior to start of the paving work at your driveway. **In order to provide for this work, Mount Lucas Road will be closed to through traffic from Jefferson Road to Cherry Hill Road and between Ewing Street and Jefferson Road during working hours of 7 am to approximately 6 pm.**

Should inclement weather occur, the work will proceed the following business day. Mount Lucas Road will reopen at the end of each work day. Residents are advised to use caution when driving within the road closure area and allow additional time for travel. Provisions will be made for emergency services vehicles and for continued services such as brush collection, mail delivery, garbage and recycling pick-up.
