IMPORTANT NOTICE REGARDING MOUNT LUCAS ROADWAY WORK

ROADWAY IMPROVEMENT WORK BETWEEN JEFFERSON ROAD AND EWING STREET

Continuing next week, Monday, June 8th through Friday, June 12th, weather permitting, Top Line Construction Corp., will continue with installation of concrete sidewalk and driveway aprons on the southbound side of Mount Lucas Road between Jefferson Road and Ewing Street and minor clean-up work on both sides. When concrete sidewalk and the concrete driveway apron are installed across your driveway, access to your driveway will be prohibited for the next 72 hours. Please park on the side of the street, away from where the work is occurring, or work with a neighbor across the street to share their driveway. We will notify you when access is restored to your driveway.

ROADWAY IMPROVEMENT WORK BETWEEN STUART ROAD EAST AND EWING STREET

No work is anticipated on this section the week of June 8th. This section of roadway will be open to traffic.

NEW JERSEY AMERICAN WATER MAIN AND SERVICES IMPROVEMENT WORK

Pending completion of new water main testing, CRJ Construction will begin service replacements within the public right-of-way between Jefferson Road and Ewing Street on Wednesday, June 10th through Friday, June 12th, weather permitting. New Jersey American Water (NJAW) will do everything possible to ensure a minimum of inconvenience while the new water service laterals are being installed. NJAW staff will knock on your door prior to any temporary interruptions (approximately 1 hour) to your water supply in the switchover process.

While this work is proceeding, Mount Lucas Road will be closed between Jefferson Road and Ewing Street during the hours of 7 am to approximately 6 pm, weekdays only.

Mount Lucas Road will reopen at the end of each work day. Residents are advised to use caution when driving within the road closure area and allow additional time for travel. Provisions will be made for emergency services vehicles and for continued services such as brush collection, mail delivery, garbage and recycling pick-up.
