

**AN ORDINANCE BY PRINCETON  
REGULATING PARKING ALONG PORTIONS  
OF HAMILTON AVENUE AND AMENDING  
THE "CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF  
PRINCETON, NEW JERSEY, 1974".**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of Princeton as follows:

Section 1. Section 19-22 of said Code establishing no parking at any time is amended with regard to Hamilton Avenue and shall read as follows:

Sec. 19-22. No parking zones

(a) No parking at any time.

(1) Designated. No person shall park a vehicle at any time upon any of the following streets or parts thereof:

*Hamilton Avenue, south side, from the east line of Harrison Street North easterly to the west line of Snowden Lane.*

Section 2. The appropriate no parking signs shall be posted to implement this no parking regulation.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication as required by law.

The purpose of this ordinance is to establish a no parking zones on Hamilton Avenue, in order to provide for on-street bike lanes.
