### **IMPORTANT NOTICE REGARDING PARDOE ROAD IMPROVEMENTS WORK**

The Municipality of Princeton has contracted with S Brothers to construct belgian block curb; minor drainage improvements; and mill and resurface the roadway from Mountain Avenue to Wilson Road. **On Tuesday, July 12, 2016, weather permitting, S Brothers Construction will begin the installation of new curb and minor drainage improvements on Pardoe Road. In order to provide for this work, Pardoe Road will be closed to through traffic from Mountain Avenue to Wilson Road and at Westerly Road. This work closure is expected to be in effect for two weeks, weekdays only, weather permitting. Work hours are generally from 7:00 am to approximately 5:00 pm, Monday through Friday.** A separate notice will be provided prior to milling and resurfacing operations which are tentatively scheduled beginning July 18th.

**When belgian block curb or drainage piping is installed across your driveway, access to your driveway will be prohibited for 48 hours. Please park in a legal space on Wilson Road or Westerly Road. We will notify you when access is restored to your driveway.**

In the event of inclement weather, work will proceed the following day, excluding Saturdays and Sundays. Pardoe Road will be closed except for local traffic only during work hours, and will reopen at the end of each work day. Residents are advised to use caution when driving within the road closure area and allow additional time for travel. Provisions will be made for emergency services vehicles and for continued services such as brush collection, mail delivery, garbage and recycling pick-up.
