## **IMPORTANT NOTICE REGARDING PARK PLACE, VANDEVENTER AVENUE, WILLOW STREET, AND MOORE STREET**

Next week, ICUNJ will continue work on Park Place, at or near the Madison Street intersection, in order to install new storm sewer piping. Storm sewer work will take place in the section of roadway between #9 and #35 Park Place. **Park Place will be closed to through traffic during work hours; however, one driveway to the Park Place parking yard will remain open and accessible.** Please use the Vandeventer Avenue driveway as the primary entrance the Park Place parking yard when possible.

Beginning May 12, weather permitting, Montana Construction will begin water main replacement work on Park Place for the New Jersey American Water Company (NJAW). The existing 4-inch water main will be replaced with a new 8-inch steel main. NJAW will be distributing a separate letter to Park Place residents regarding this much needed upgrade.

Adjacent properties on the affected street(s) will be notified as needed to remove vehicles prior to the start of work each day. Parking will be allowed in non-metered, legal parking spaces on other municipal roads where work will not be taking place. If you need to park your car on the street overnight, please contact Deanna Stockton, [dstockton@princetonnj.gov](mailto:dstockton@princetonnj.gov), to obtain a temporary parking placard, which must be placed on the dashboard of the driver's side front windshield.

Provisions will be made for continued services such as brush collection, mail delivery, garbage and recycling pick-up. The road will be reopened to full two-way traffic and parking at the end of each work day.

**Regarding driveway, sidewalk and landscape area restoration, ICUNJ will make permanent repairs to these areas just prior to final paving later this summer. If you have an immediate safety concern, please contact the Engineering Department to review the situation.**
