IMPORTANT NOTICE REGARDING PARK PLACE, VANDEVENTER AVENUE, WIGGINS STREET, MOORE STREET, AND WILLOW STREET

Next week, Integrated Construction and Utilities of New Jersey (ICUNJ) will be continuing with the repair and replacement of the sanitary sewer system within Park Place and Lancha Construction will be replacing sidewalks along Vandeventer Avenue. The work is planned as follows:

Monday, weather permitting, Lancha Construction will remove and replace marked sidewalks and driveway aprons on the east side of Vandeventer Avenue starting at Wiggins Street and continuing toward Spring Street / Park Place.

Vandeventer Avenue will be closed in the northbound direction between Nassau Street and Wiggins Street, and in the southbound direction between Wiggins Street and Spring Street between the hours of 7:00 am and 6:00 pm. Please note, if your sidewalk within your driveway is replaced, you will not be able to access your driveway for a period of 48 to 72 hours after the new concrete is installed. Please see the next page for parking options during this period.

Monday, weather permitting, ICUNJ will start work at 6:00 am to enlarge the existing pipe and install a new pipe within the sanitary sewer main on Park Place between Madison Street and Branch Alley. This operation will include inserting approximately 150 feet of plastic pipe within the existing sanitary sewer. When the installation takes place on Monday, weather permitting, the entire length of Park Place will be closed. If you live on Park Place, you will not be able to access your neighborhood by motor vehicle while the work is proceeding. **However, the Park Place parking lot will be accessible from Madison Street during this time. Please note, for the duration of this operation on Monday, the eastern driveway from Park Place into the parking lot will be closed, and the western driveway from Park Place will allow ingress and egress to Madison Street.**

If you live or work on the south side of Park Place between Madison Street and Branch Alley you will be asked to refrain from washing clothes, running your dishwasher and/or discharging other sources of sewage on Monday until the work is completed that evening.

It is anticipated that the Contractor will complete work by approximately 8:00 pm on Monday evening.

Tuesday and Wednesday, weather permitting, the contractor, ICUNJ, will move its sewer lateral repair operation to the section of Park Place between Branch Alley and Moore Street. Lancha Construction will continue to remove and replace sidewalk on Vandeventer Avenue, weather permitting.

Adjacent properties on the affected street(s) will be notified as needed to remove vehicles prior to the start of work each day. Parking will be allowed in non-metered, legal parking spaces on other municipal roads where work will not be taking place. If you need to park your car on the street overnight, please contact Chris Knigge, cknigge@princetonnj.gov, to obtain a temporary parking placard, which must be placed on the dashboard of the driver's side front windshield.

If you will not have access to your property because of the sidewalk or sanitary sewer work, you may be able to park for free (upon validation by parking garage staff) at the Spring Street garage. In order to use this opportunity, please email the following information to Bill Moraski, Parking Superintendent, at bmoraski@princetonnj.gov: your name, address, cell phone number, and make / model / license plate number.

Provisions will be made for continued services such as mail delivery, garbage and recycling pick-up. The road will be reopened to full two-way traffic and parking at the end of each work day.
