## **IMPORTANT NOTICE REGARDING VANDEVENTER AVENUE AND PARK PLACE**

**On Thursday, August 28, 2014, weather permitting, the contractor will be installing the final surface pavement on Park Place from Moore Street to Vandeventer Avenue and Vandeventer Avenue from Nassau Street to Wiggins Street. The work is scheduled to begin on Park Place at Moore Street and progress toward Vandeventer Avenue. The work is planned to begin at 7:00 am and is anticipated to be completed by the end of the work day, weather permitting.**

**If you require use of your vehicle on Thursday, Vandeventer Avenue and Park Place residents are asked to remove vehicles from their driveways beginning on Wednesday night or early Thursday morning, prior to the start of work.** Residents will not be permitted to park vehicles on Vandeventer Avenue or Park Place due to the work being performed on the roadways. Residents will be allowed to park in legal on-street non-metered parking spaces on Madison Avenue, Moore Street, Spruce Street, and Wiggins Street - Hamilton Avenue where work is not taking place. Vehicles should not be parked near intersections in order to allow access for the paving equipment.

The Park Place access to the Park Place East parking lot will be closed throughout this operation; it will be accessible only from Moore Street while Park Place is being paved.

Spring Street will be closed to thru traffic at North Tulane Street while Vandeventer Avenue is being paved. Police traffic control directors and detours will be in place to move traffic around the work area.

Access to the Park Place West parking lot will shift during this paving operation. The general plan is to keep the Park Place driveways open as long as possible, and then reopen them as soon as possible. In this regard, access to the lot will be provided via the driveway from Vandeventer Avenue when Park Place is being paved. When Vandeventer Avenue is being paved, access to the lot will be provided via Madison Street. Email updates and Nixle alerts will be utilized to inform you of the openings and closings.

**After the final paving of the roadway is completed, you will be prohibited from using the road for a 2-hour period up until approximately 7 pm.** This restriction will prevent permanent marring of the blacktop during its "curing period". Residents should have access to their driveways after 7 pm at the end of the day. In the event of inclement weather, the work will proceed on the following day.

Collection of garbage will take place before 7:00 am on Thursday morning; please place your bin at the curb prior to 6:00 am.

In addition to the electronic distribution of this notice, we will hand-deliver a copy of the notice with a temporary parking permit for affected residents.

Please be advised that the pavement striping (crosswalks, stop bars, etc.) has been scheduled for Tuesday and Wednesday of the following week, September 2 and 3, 2014. The lining of the sanitary sewer has tentatively been rescheduled to be completed in third and fourth weeks of September. Additional notice will be provided prior to this work proceeding.
