SANITARY SEWER REPAIR WORK ON GUYOT AVENUE NEAR CARNAHAN PLACE

During a recent sanitary sewer inspection, Princeton Sewer Operating Committee (PSOC) has determined that a section of the sanitary sewer main on Guyot Avenue near Carnahan Place is in need of repair. To minimize disturbance during the repair process, PSOC's contractor, ICUNJ, will utilize a trenchless replacement technique by inserting a new pipe into the existing pipe.

On **Monday, June 6th** and **Tuesday, June 7th**, weather permitting, ICUNJ plans to repair this sanitary sewer pipe. Some minor noise and vibrations may be experienced in the immediate vicinity of the work during this process. **To provide for these repairs, Guyot Avenue (Carnahan Place to Witherspoon Street) and Carnahan Place will be closed to through traffic during the working hours of 7 am to approximately 4 pm.** The following will be in effect while the work is proceeding:

- **The on-street parking on Guyot Avenue (Carnahan Place to Witherspoon Street) will be temporarily suspended.** The displaced cars should be parked in a legal parking space on Carnahan Place, Witherspoon Street, and Henry Avenue. The 2-hour parking limit will not be enforced on these streets while this work is proceeding.
- **Access to Conte's parking lot will be accessible from Witherspoon Street via Guyot Avenue.**
- **The exit drive of the Valley Road PPS Administration building will be open, vehicles exiting this drive will be directed to exit via Carnahan Place to Henry Avenue.**
- **The residents with driveways on Guyot Avenue (Carnahan Place to Witherspoon Street) are requested to move cars to a nearby location on Witherspoon Street or on Carnahan Place prior to the start of the work and can move cars back to the driveways once the work is completed.**

The roadway will reopen at the end of each work day. Residents are advised to use caution when driving within the road closure area and allow additional time for travel. Provisions will be made for emergency services vehicles and for continued services such as brush collection, mail delivery, garbage and recycling pick-up.
