IMPORTANT NOTICE REGARDING VAN DYKE ROAD SEWER WORK
BETWEEN ALL SAINTS ROAD AND SNOWDEN LANE
(PART OF SNOWDEN SANITARY SEWER PROJECT)

On Thursday, November 10th, weather permitting, ICUNJ will install laterals from the sanitary sewer main on Van Dyke Road between All Saints Road and Snowden Lane. **While this work is proceeding, Van Dyke Road will be closed to through traffic between All Saints Road and Snowden Lane during the working hours of 7AM to approximately 5PM. Snowden Lane will be open to through traffic in both directions between Overbrook Drive and Herrontown Road.** A detour will be posted on Van Dyke Road/Terhune Road at the intersection of Meadowbrook Drive/Braeburn Drive for eastbound traffic on Van Dyke/Terhune wishing to continue on to Snowden Lane.

Access to individual driveways on Van Dyke Road should not be restricted while this work is being completed.

In observance of the Veterans Day holiday on Friday November 11, 2016, the contractor will not work at the Snowden Lane project.

For residents on Van Dyke Road between Snowden Lane and All Saints Road, please have your garbage and recycling ready the night before the pick-up day as the hauler has been requested to do a pick-up prior to ICUNJ begins work at 7AM.

Should inclement weather occur, the work will proceed the following business day. The roadway will reopen at the end of each work day. Residents are advised to use caution when driving within the road closure area and allow additional time for travel. Provisions will be made for emergency services vehicles and for continued services such as brush collection, mail delivery, garbage and recycling pick-up.
