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IMPORTANT NOTICE REGARDING SNOWDEN LANE & VAN DYKE ROAD SEWER WORK

On Monday, November 14, and through Friday November 18th, weather permitting, ICUNJ will continue installation of the new sewer main on Snowden Lane, installation of sewer laterals on Van Dyke Road and restoration of the Snowden Lane asphalt surface.

Below is tentative schedule of activities. Working hours are 7AM to approximately 5PM for each day. This schedule is subject to change. Detours will be posted at appropriate locations according to location of work.

Monday, November 14 - Snowden Lane will be closed between Van Dyke Road and Herrontown Road to continue installation of the new sewer main on Snowden Lane.

Tuesday, November 15 - Van Dyke Road will be closed between All Saints Road and Snowden Lane to install sewer laterals on Van Dyke Road.

Wednesday, November 16 through Friday, November 18th - Snowden Lane will be closed between Herrontown Road and Overbrook Drive to temporarily restore the asphalt road surface of Snowden Lane disturbed by construction activities.

Work on Snowden Lane or Van Dyke Street will block access to individual driveways when work is directly in front of your residence for approximately 8 hours. When work is scheduled to be in front of your residence on Snowden Lane, please park on the south side of Van Dyke Road. When work is scheduled to be in front of your residence on Van Dyke Road, please park on Van Dyke Road between 63 Van Dyke Road and All Saints Road. After the work passes your house, you will again be able to park in your driveway.

For residents on Snowden Lane and Van Dyke Road, please have your garbage and recycling ready the night before the pick-up day as the hauler has been requested to do a pick-up prior to ICUNJ begins work at 7AM.

Should inclement weather occur, the work will proceed the following business day. The roadway will reopen at the end of each work day. Residents are advised to use caution when driving within the road closure area and allow additional time for travel. Provisions will be made for emergency services vehicles and for continued services such as brush collection, mail delivery, garbage and recycling pick-up.
